### **REAL Plastics Report**

REAL has recently published a report presenting an analysis of BCS and CCS data on plastic contamination in samples submitted by certified operators for routine testing or re-tests after a failure. This analysis was conducted to contribute to the revision of the Anaerobic Digestate Quality Protocol, and examines the failure rate of samples in England, Wales, and Northern Ireland against the current limits for plastics in PAS 110, as well as against SEPA's tighter plastic limits.

The analysis shows that 98.7% of digestate samples taken between 1st January 2022 and 31st July 2023 passed against the PAS 110 limit. The level of physical contaminants in the majority of digestate samples was 0.36 kg/t.
