An Example of a Quality Policy

The purpose of the Quality Policy is to clearly set out the producer's commitment to achieving quality digestate and to fulfilling customer requirements.

The Quality Policy shall include clear identification of location of the digestion site, the type(s) of processes employed and what types of digested material are produced.

Policy statement:

It is the aim of WasteXL Ltd of Gasbury, Herts to produce digestate of the highest quality and fit for purpose with the aim of fulfilling customer requirements, on the site which is defined in the attached site map.

Vehicle to Achieving the Policy:

In order to achieve the above statement, the production system will be established in such a way as to comply with all the requirements of:

BSI's Publicly Available Specification for whole digestate, separated liquor and separated fibre derived from the anaerobic digestion of source-segregated biodegradable materials.

And

WRAP and the Environment Agency's Quality Protocol for Anaerobic Digestate.

Digestate Products :

The whole digestate produced at this plant is pressed through a 1mm screen to separate liquor from fibre. No additives are used.

Separated Liquor:

This product will be used as an agricultural fertiliser and spread on land in accordance to the relevant codes of practice and in compliance with the Quality Protocol for Anaerobic Digestate.

Separated Fibre:

This product will be mixed with shredded woody waste to form quality compost in an aerobic windrow system certified to PAS100.
