If you are seeking to validate/certify new fractions of digestate, please contact us on info@realschemes.org.uk to obtain a temporary certification code. The PAS 110 Digestate Analysis Request Form is to be used when sending any samples for certification purposes with the certified code added to this form. The Approved Laboratories use this unique code to upload the test results to a central database which is accessed by your certification body.
